- 1 Aldrich Hall**
Aldrich Hall is one of the most important buildings on campus. It houses the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships, as well as the Registrar's Office.
- 2 Paul Merage School of Business**
This school offers majors in business information management and business administration. Students can participate in the New Venture Competition, UC Irvine's own version of Shark Tank.
- 3 School of Education**
Education science majors get to complete 40 hours of field work in classrooms, tutoring, or even after school programs.
- 4 School of Law**
Students can become Double Anteaters by earning their Bachelor's degree and Juris Doctor degree in six years instead of seven through the 3+3 Articulated Program!
- 5 School of Social Ecology**
Majors include psychological science; criminology, law, and society; urban studies, and more! Students get to complete 80 hours in field study projects.
- 6 School of Social Sciences**
The largest academic unit on campus, this school offers majors such as political science, anthropology, business economics, and more!
- 7 Middle Earth Towers**
Built in 2019, this housing community is the newest on campus.
- 8 Aldrich Park**
This beautiful central park is home to UC Irvine's most memorable events, such as the Anteater Involvement Fair and Aldrich Park After Dark.
- 9 Henry Samueli School of Engineering**
This school offers multiple majors such as aerospace, biomedical, and chemical engineering. Opportunities include building rovers, studying rockets, and more!
- 10 Donald Bren School of Information and Computer Sciences**
UC Irvine is the only UC with an independent computer science school. Students get to participate in several Hackathon events!
- 11 School of Physical Sciences**
This school offers seven majors, three minors, and a nuclear reactor for students and faculty to conduct research.
- 12 Susan & Henry Samueli College of Health Sciences**
Founded in 2017, this college works side-by-side with UCI Health in improving medical practice and patient care through the education of the next healthcare professionals.
- 13 Joe C. Wen School of Population & Public Health**
UC Irvine is the first UC with an undergraduate public health program! Students get to complete 100 hours of field work alongside accredited professionals.
- 14 Sue & Bill Gross School of Nursing**
This specialized program allows students the opportunity to participate in clinical rotations, which provides a path to becoming a registered nurse upon graduation.
- 15 Charlie Dunlop School of Biological Sciences**
This school offers majors such as biological sciences, ecology and evolutionary biology, and biology and education. Learn more by attending the quarterly Donuts with the Dean.
- 16 Science Library**
A favorite study spot on campus, this library boasts six floors, a writing center, multimedia center, and the Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program (UROP).
- 17 School of Humanities**
Home to over 22 majors, this school is also home to UC Irvine's own radio show and newspaper, KUCI and the New University.
- 18 Bren Events Center**
A multipurpose facility that holds up to 6,000 people for concerts, athletic games, and commencement.
- 19 Claire Trevor School of the Arts**
Majors include drama, dance, music, and art. It also boasts clubs such as Uniting Voices, Digifilm Society, Metro Theatre Company, and many more!
- 20 Mesa Court**
With three towers and 29 classics, all residents have access to a gym, dining hall, and study spaces.

- 21 Student Center**
This hub includes the veterans services center, ASUCI department, esports arena, food courts, and the Hill bookstore and gift shop.
- 22 University Town Center (UTC)**
Located across Campus Drive, this shopping center and popular hangout spot has stops such as In-N-Out, Trader Joe's, Taco Bell, and Target.
- 23 Anteater Recreation Center (ARC)**
The ARC offers a rock climbing wall, basketball and volleyball courts, two indoor gyms, tennis courts, intramural sports, and much more!
- 24 Arroyo Vista Housing**
A housing community with themes such as chemistry, culinary, and international students.
